## Otter Class Trip to Sevington School

On Friday 6th May, Otter Class travelled back in time to the reign of Queen Victoria! Children wore Victorian outfits to attend Sevington School for the day, where they had lessons in the authentic Victorian classroom, learning 'The Three Rs' (Reading, Writing and Arithmetic). Boys and girls were taught separately for most of the day. Boys collected beeswax, which they used to make candles, and learnt about gardening and harvesting fruit and vegetables. The girls made lavender bags and spent time in the scullery polishing brassware. At lunchtime, children enjoyed a traditional Victorian lunch of bread, cheese, cold potatoes, pasties and homemade cake, which they had made the day before. At the end of the day, children played some Victorian games outside. Everyone was completely immersed in the Victorian way of life and it was a fantastic experience for the children and staff!
