We raised £50



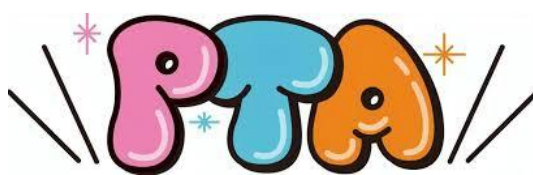
Page to Plate – half term homework

Please drop these in to Elspeth at school.

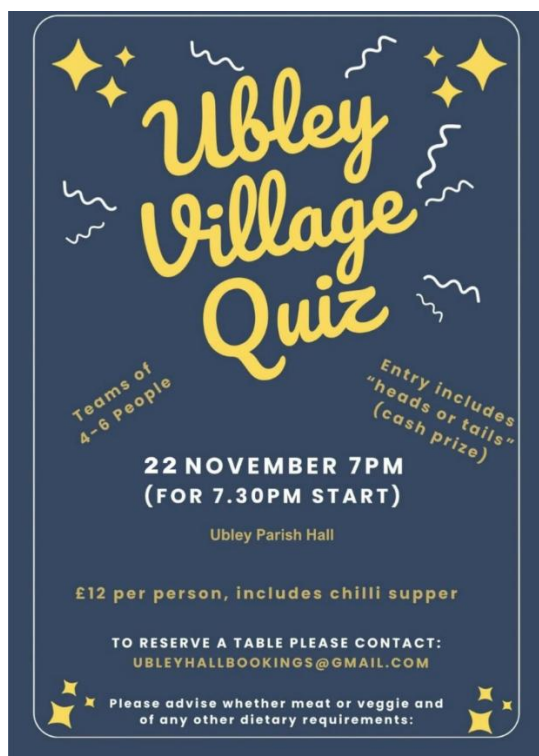
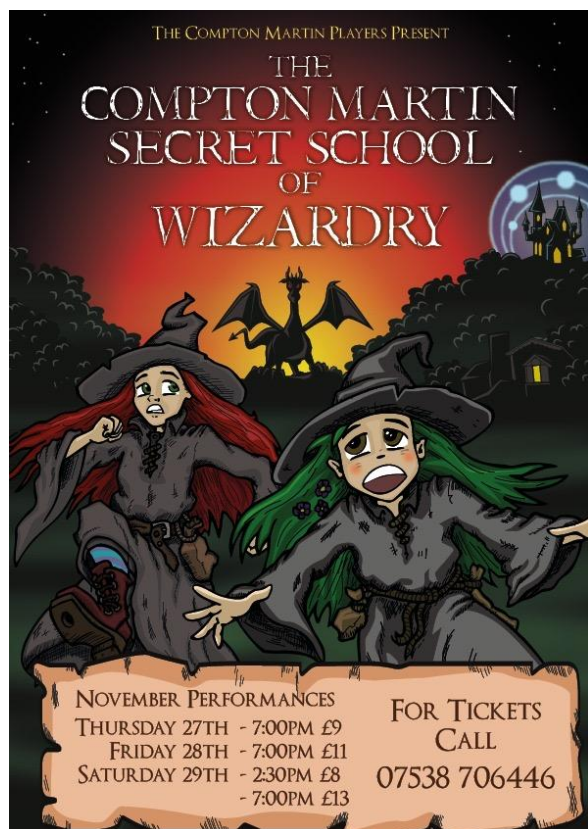
PTA Winter Craft Market
