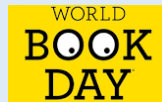

Well done to Squirrel class who won the trophy for the most doodle maths points this week.



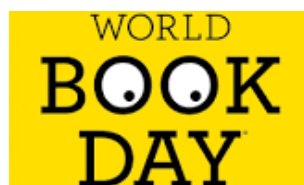
Visiting Author

A reminder that the LSP Attendance Policy states that absences should only be granted in exceptional circumstances and a family holiday does not constitute such an exception.

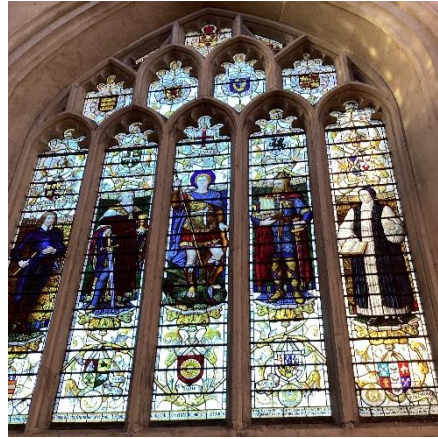
