**Hedgehog Class** – Harriet for using her physical skills not just in PE but in school.



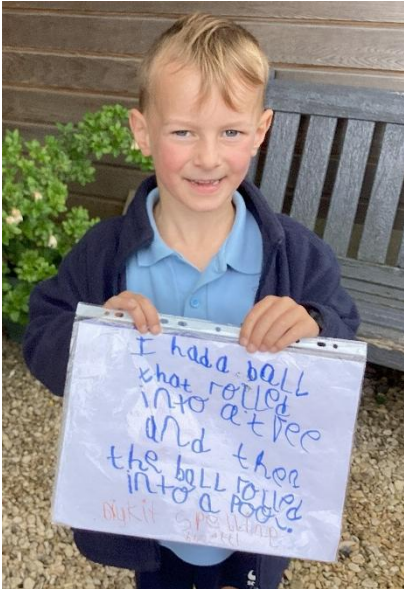
## Caring, Capable and Confident

3<sup>rd</sup> place Hedgehog Class with 309 stars

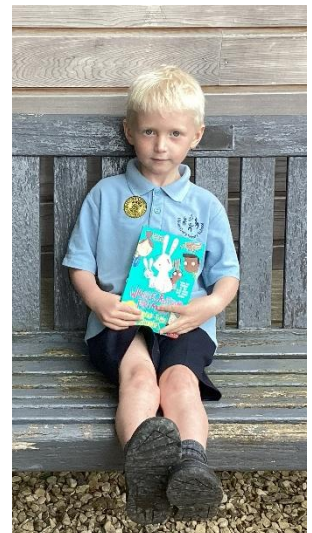
