Keep up the amazing work everyone!



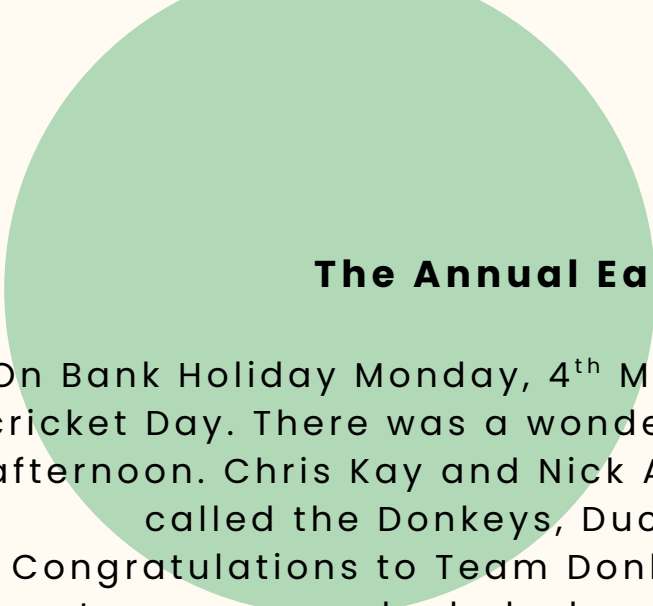
Sir David Attenborough's Birthday

It was a wonderful opportunity to learn outdoors, and the children have learned so much today about the importance of nature, biodiversity, and looking after our planet.

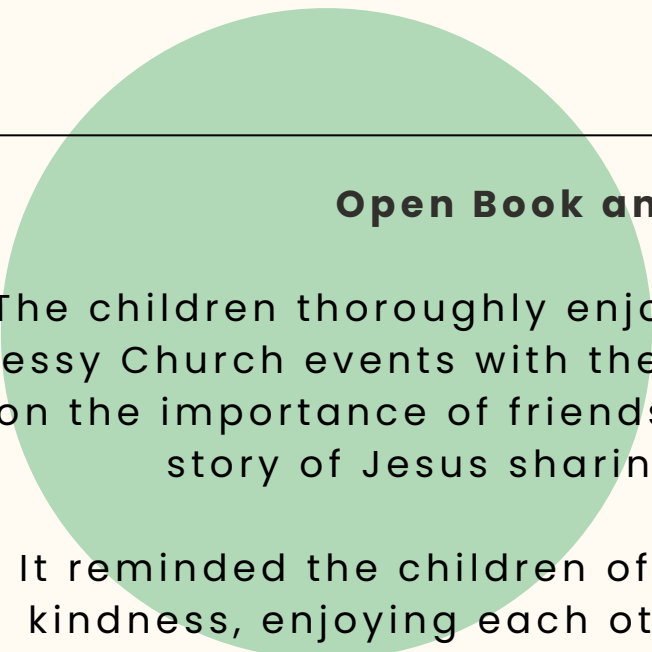




The Annual East Harptree Cricket Day
