

Car parking for parents and carers

Discussions with the new tenant of the Waldegrave Arms are in the final stages, so festive drinks are in sight! When the pub opens, we all wish for the Waldy to do a roaring trade. This means there must be enough parking for patrons during opening hours. To ensure this happens, the following pub car park plan for parents and carers is in place from 28th October.

The pub car park is available for drop off between 8:45 and 9am and pick up between 3.15 and 3.45pm but not outside of these times. Park in the main car park to leave the front of the pub clear.

All pub business (such as barrel and food deliveries) takes priority, so please be prepared to park elsewhere if the entrance is in use. For all other school activities outside these agreed times, including clubs, parents' evenings, performances and so on, please find a spot nearby, such as on Whitecross Rd or in the pavilion car park in Townsend (a five-minute walk away).
