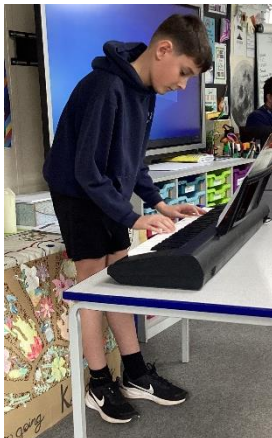
Celebration Assembly

This will be held at Ubley Church on Sunday 30th March at 10am, come along for fun, posy making, worship, activities and gifts for mum.

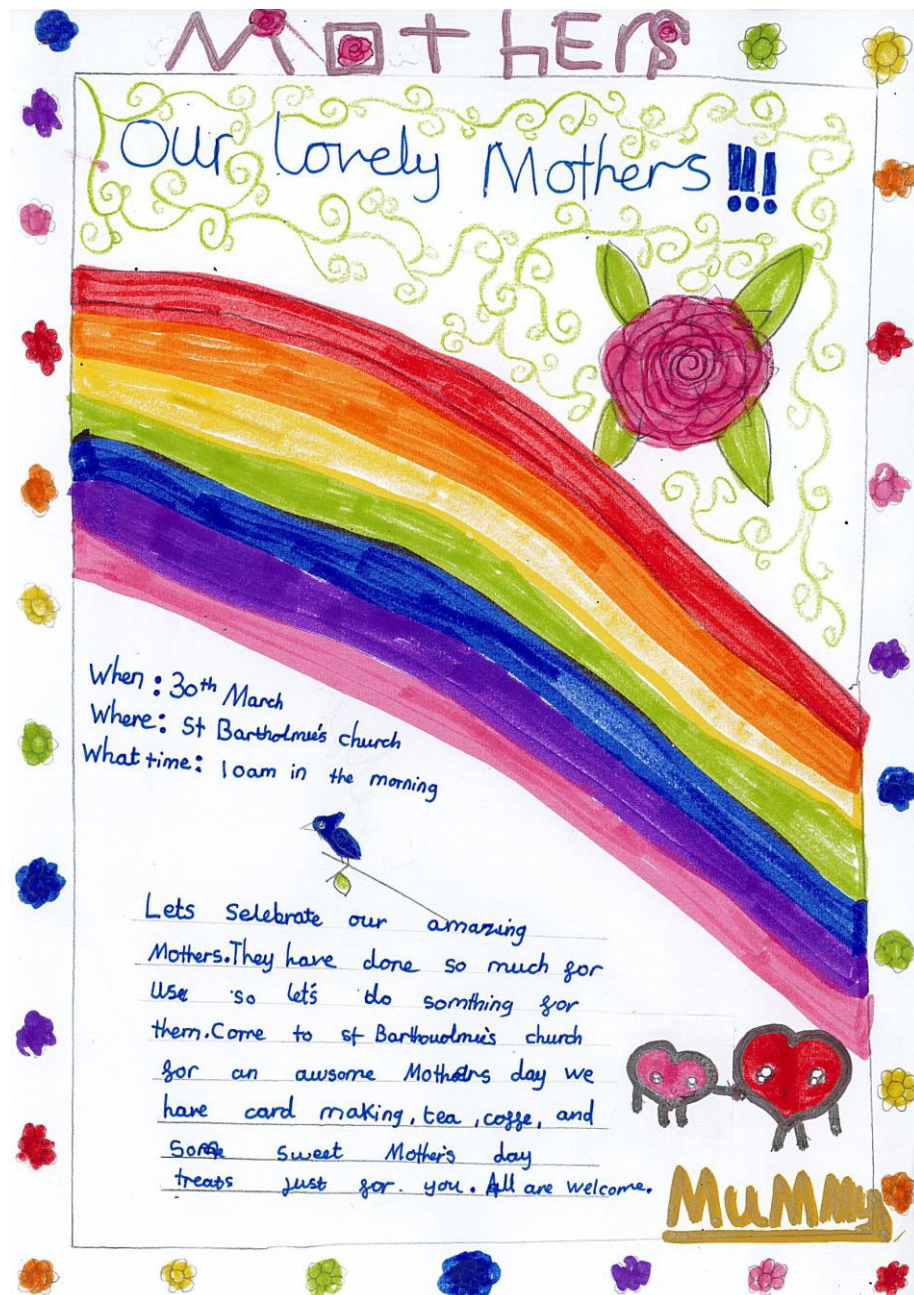
Coffee and cake to start!
