This week in Squirrels' History lessons, the children have been learning about the Egyptians looking at how different the rich and poor lived. The children created a playscript using the information they have learned covering different lifestyles. In English, the class have been learning fronted adverbials and dialogue and creating pieces of writing based on the book 'Black Dog' by Levi Pinfold about overcoming fears. The children wrote their own versions of the story. During Maths, the class have been covering multiplication with two and three digit numbers and division of two digit numbers.







A bit of Bob Marley was enjoyed during their music lesson which was studying pulse and during Design and Technology (DT), the children have been looking at structure and stability using picture frames. This involved the children planning their own designs and making them. Henry said 'it was fun and creative. I enjoyed measuring and cutting out the cardboard'. ## Requests for leave of absence during term time

A reminder that the LSP Attendance Policy states that absences should only be granted in exceptional circumstances and a family holiday does not constitute such an exception.

The Lighthouse Schools Partnership policy is in line with the May 2022 statutory guidance to schools. In almost all cases a request for a holiday in term time will have to be refused and if the unauthorised holiday is for 5 or more full days it will incur a Penalty Notice.
