

## English Writing -

We will be learning to write narratives, letters, instructions and poems based on the books: Toys in Space, Dragon Post, The Comet and Lubna & Pebble.

Our grammar focus will be:

- Adjectives & expanded noun phrases
- Coordinating conjunctions & time conjunctions
- Verbs and adverbs



## PE: - Mondays and Thursdays

Foxes will be learning ball skills this term, through invasion games as well as putting together a sequence of movements in gymnastics.

## Reading -

We will enjoy reading a variety of fiction and non-fiction together as a class as well as individually. Reading skills will be taught and supported by our new ULS Phonics scheme.

History - as historians, we will be learning about The Great Fire of London, how it started, what factors contributed to its ferocity, and its lasting impact on London.

Geography - as geographers, we will investigate cold climates. Our enquiry questions will be: What is it like at the North and South Poles?

Art - as artists, we will be using textiles and collage to create pictures of the Great Fire of London as well as exploring other mediums such as pastels and paint.

DT - as designers, we will be learning to sew as a joining technique and creating our own mini finger puppets and some larger glove puppets!



# FOX CLASS LEARNING

## Autumn terms 1 & 2

## Maths -



Foxes will be developing their understanding of number and place value, recognising number bonds to help them add and subtract numbers to 20 and numbers to 100, as well as exploring 2D and 3D shapes.

## Religious Education

In RE, we will investigate Christian beliefs about God, learn about why Jesus used parables, discuss the story of 'The Prodigal Son' and the ways in which Christians worship God. Our school value this term is thankfulness.

## Music

In Music, Foxes will be exploring pulse and rhythm, learning to use percussion to play a steady beat or perform a rhythm, and to share group compositions with their classmates.

## Science

As scientists, Foxes will be learning about animals, including humans, their requirements for survival, what we need for a healthy diet, and why exercise is so important.

## Computing

In Computing, Foxes will be learning about computer systems and networks as well as using digital photography to create media.
