Indie was particularly thrilled with their achievements as she received a special treat too!





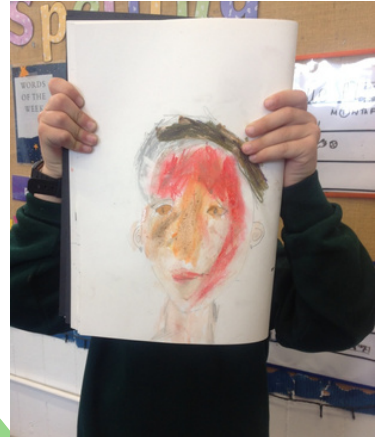
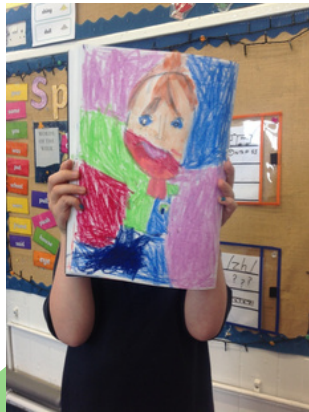
## Out of School Achievements
