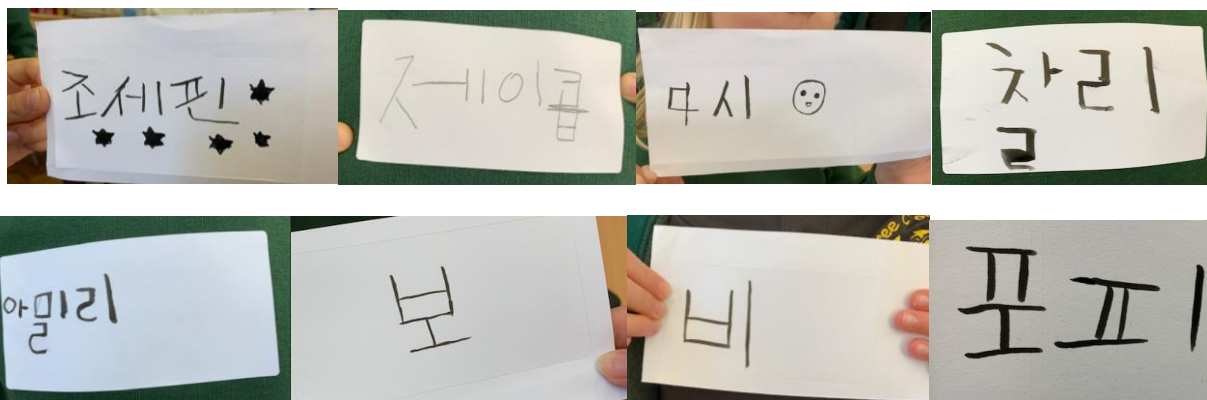
Register your organisation, group or service, for free, on Live Well B&NES
