Squirrels - Olivia for her courage and patience in learning her time tables and beating her own targets.

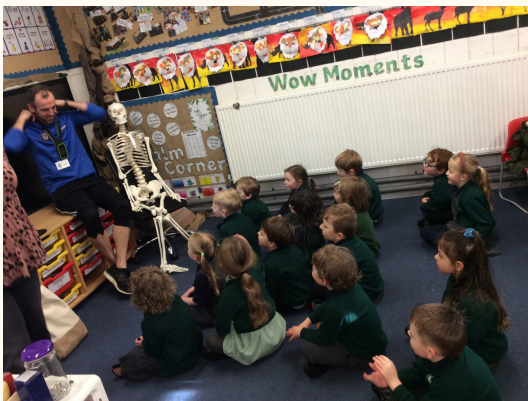
Otters - Frank for his relentless dedication to every subject and pride in his work . He perseveres in every lesson to complete each task even if it means going into his own time a little bit.

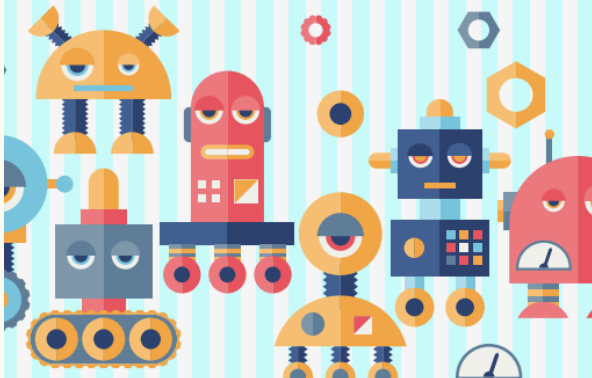
