Hedgehogs for being the top Doodlers for Doodle maths this week. Mrs Haskins says "keep up the good work!"

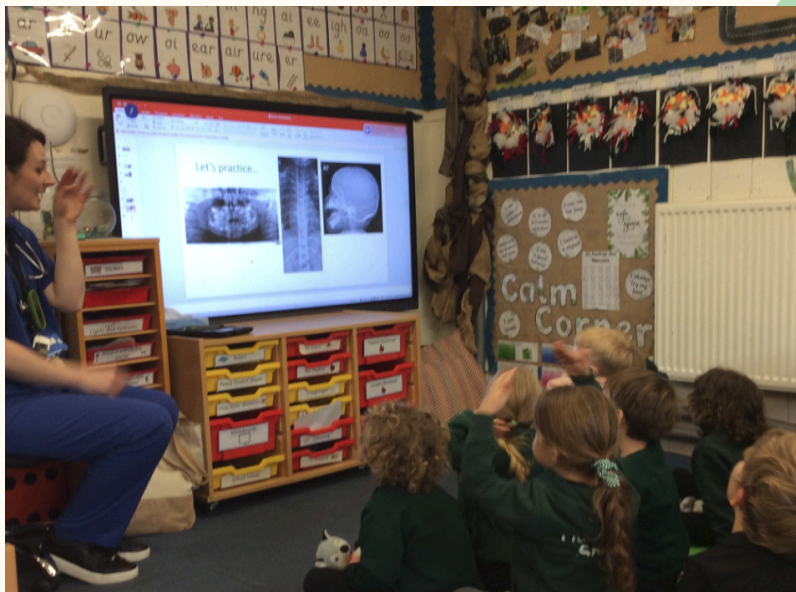


PEOPLE WHO HELP US
