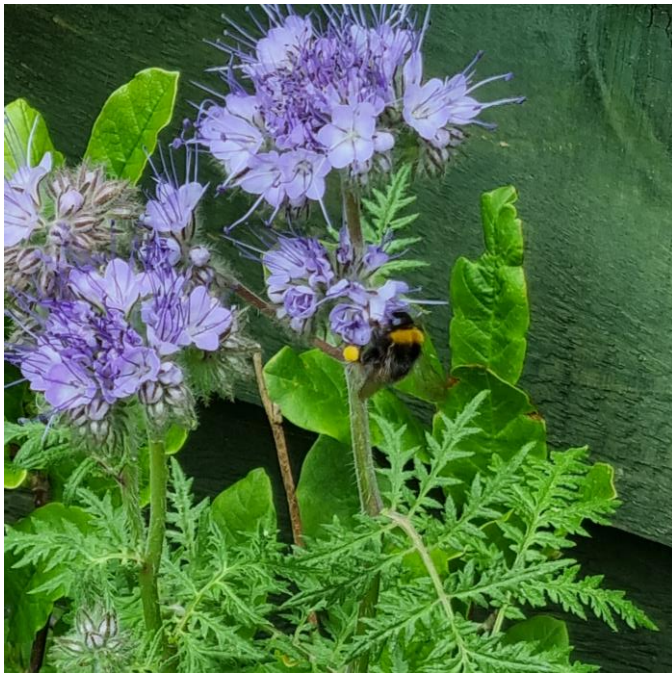
PARKING

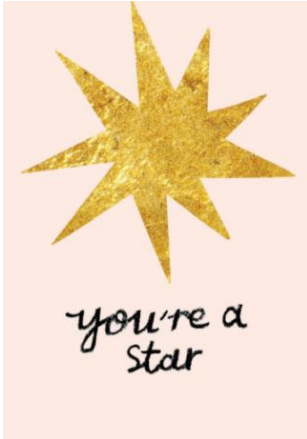
