Cake Sale

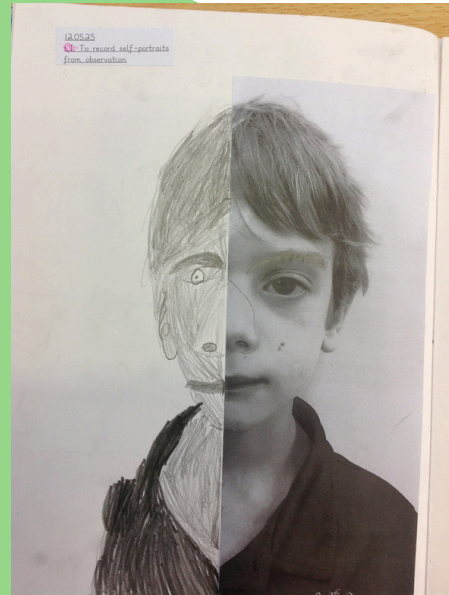
