Whole School Drama Workshops

On Thursday we welcomed professional facilitators from Valley Arts, to lead drama-based workshops for all of our children. Fairy tales and storytelling were used to explore gender stereotypes, while building some simple drama skills. The creative approach used aims to increase childrens' confidence, inspire creative thinking, and improve problem solving and presentation skills.
